#### 1. What MBA prerequisites can be fulfilled through CLEP?

- \*Accounting
- \*Marketing

#### 2. What is the required score?

Scores should rank at or above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile nationally.

#### 3. How do I prepare for the test?

- As a start, review some sample questions to determine your current knowledge. There is also a percentage breakdown of content covered on the test. Please see next page for more detailed suggestions.
- Assess how much you need to learn and the time you have.
- Find the appropriate study materials.
- Go for it!

#### 4. Where do I take the test?

This site will help you more strategically prepare for the test.

- At CLEP.com, click on "For Students"
- Under "College Board Tests," click on "CLEP"
- Click on "Preparing" in the left tool bar. You will see a number of different helpful topics.

#### 2. [www.4Tests.com](http://www.4Tests.com)

Go to this website and click on "view all exams" and a large number of sample CLEP tests will appear that can be opened and taken. They are not full length, but they do have about 30 questions per exam. Once you have completed the exam, it will grade it, show all the right answers, and provide a detailed explanation of the answers.

Go to this website and click on "test preps" and you can view the "CLEP series" by selecting it. A good number of CLEP study guides are available for individual tests at a reasonable price. There are some good "CLIFF NOTES" style books available as well. They serve as a good study supplement.
